The following information is a brief outline of the work your children will be covering in term 3.

Our Learning Adventure this term is titled “Cracking Climates!”

Across the curriculum we are going to be climate explorers, investigating the world’s climates, what is climate change, why it is happening and how we can do something about it.

English – for the first week the children will be looking at the picture book “The Journey Home” by Frann Preston-Gannon. Following on from this, activities will include descriptive writing, diaries, poetry and persuasive letter writing.

DT – continuing the Learning Adventure (looking after the environment) – the children will produce a bird feeder made from recycled materials.

Maths – fractions and measurement. Please continue to practise times tables.
