The Eastbourne food bank has plenty of:

- Beans
- Sugar
- Cereal
- Soup

Our food bank is part of The Trussell Trust's network of 428 food banks, working to tackle food poverty and hunger in our local communities, as well as across the UK.

The Food bank Network was founded in 2004 after four years of developing the original food bank based in Salisbury. Since then The Trussell Trust has helped communities work together to launch food banks nationwide in a wide range of towns and cities.

In 2016/17, The Trussell Trust's Food bank Network provided 1,182,954 three-day emergency food supplies and support to UK people in crisis. Of these, over 430,000 went to children.

Donations of food can be brought straight to the hall on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October from 8.30am onwards.
