## Ocklynge Junior School's Beliefs:

- Ocklynge Junior School believes that online safety is an essential part of safeguarding and acknowledges its duty to ensure that all pupils and staff are protected from potential harm online.
- Ocklynge Junior School believes that pupils should be empowered to build resilience and to develop strategies to manage and respond to risk online.

The internet and associated devices, such as computers, tablets, mobile phones and games consoles, are an important part of everyday life, so in order to be able to achieve the above we would like all members of the school community to commit to keeping our children safe.

### As a parent/carer I will:

- Read the Internet Golden Rule (Acceptable Use Policy) and encourage my children to adhere to them.
- Support the school's online safety approaches by discussing online safety issues with my children and reinforcing appropriate and safe online behaviours at home.
- Role model safe and appropriate use of technology and social media (such as sharing images, text and video responsibly).
- Abide by the home-school agreement and Internet Golden Rules.
- Identify changes in behaviour that could indicate that my child is at risk of harm online.
- Seek help and support from the school, or other appropriate agencies, if I or my child encounters risk or concerns online.
- Use the school's systems, such as the school's website, facebook, and other network resources, safely and appropriately.
- Take responsibility for my own awareness in relation to the risks and opportunities posed by new and emerging technologies.
