KS2: 7-11 YEARS

Age group of learner	KS2/7-11 years
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This session is designed to take no more than 30 minutes. However, the session can be shortened or lengthened over a number of days depending on your setting. Each activity could be completed on a different day over a week.

Outcome for the session		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will be aware of the decisions they make using technology. • Children will make safer decisions online. 	
Extension activities		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is a session all about talk and discussion. • Teachers could put together a 'Using Tech Safely' board in their room. • There is some opportunity for songs and raps to be made with the key messages. 	
How will you know the children are learning?		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will show understanding through questioning and participation. • In the longer term, it will be evident that the children change the way they search or set passwords. 	
Time	Activity	Resource	Outcome
2 mins	Question (dependent on title): What do we mean by Digital Footprint? What is a social network? What is the purpose of social networks?	PPT.	Children establish the focus area of the session and have a collective understanding of the terms.

20 mins	<p>Run through the slides in the PowerPoint.</p> <p>There are questions to ask on the notes for each slide (see handout). Give children a chance to talk to each other and discuss each question.</p>	<p>PPT.</p> <p>Handout.</p> <p>Let the discussion flow away from these questions if necessary.</p>	<p>Children talk about their use of technology and begin to understand the safest decisions to make online.</p>
5 mins	<p>Ask the children for one thing they are going to do differently as a result of this session.</p>		<p>Children make a decision about one way they will improve their safe use of technology.</p>
Extension 1	<p>Using Tech Safely Board.</p> <p>If you have a spare display board it is a good idea to get the children to write down one commitment on a piece of paper (shape it like a monitor, mouse, mobile etc) and display all their commitments on the wall. Over time this will build to a powerful display for the way children will use technology in a safer way.</p>		
Extension 2	<p>Choose a well known song or nursery rhyme and work with the children to change the lyrics to fit an online safety message.</p> <p>This is an example from Anson Primary School in Brent.</p> <p>Stay Safe Online: https://youtu.be/4xCkBJu_IZY</p>	<p>Access to YouTube</p> <p>Song lyrics.</p> <p>Recording device.</p>	<p>Children apply their 'using tech safely' knowledge.</p> <p>Children share their work to help other children stay safe.</p>
